
## Lithodora Grace Ward

## Lithodora diffusa 'Grace Ward'

- <u>Use:</u> This is an old rock garden favorite with deep cobalt-blue flowers, justly popular for nearly a century.
   Mounding stems with small, evergreen foliage form low, spreading hummocks that bloom late spring and early summer, in full sun and well-drained soil.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Prefers full sun with a little shade during the hot afternoon sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry to start. Take care to keep soil moist. Water under the leaves.
- Growth: Moderate-growing to 6-10" high, 2-3' wide.
- Hardiness: 6-9, Perennial
- Foliage: Small leaves.
- Flower: True blue flowers from March until past July.
