Variegated Moneywort



This small, creeping variety is perfect for the front of the garden, cascading over stone walls and in rock or alpine gardens. Our favorite use is in window boxes and mixed planters. Moneywort prefers well-drained soils. Very striking!

Lysimachia congestifola "Variegata"

- <u>Use:</u> Forms a mat of small yellow and lime green variegated leaves with masses of golden-yellow bellflowers. Excellent for covering large areas in part to full shade quickly. Use in hanging baskets, containers and window boxes. Deer resistant.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Prefers full sun(would need a fair amount of regular watering) to shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Drought tolerant when established, but prefers moist soil.
- **Growth:** The non-invasive stems spread out to 6-8" high and 10-12" wide each season.
- *Hardiness:* Zone 7-9; Perennial
- <u>Foliage</u>: Deciduous. Small yellow and green variegated foliage.
- <u>Flower:</u> Covered with yellow orange blooms all summer long! Self-cleaning, no deadheading necessary.
