Creeping Jenny



Lysimachia nummularia 'Aurea'

- <u>Use:</u> A nice perennial ground cover with chartreuse leaves that looks like a string of small coins. It can be used in bog situations or at the water's edge, as it can stand to be in as much as 2" of water. Also works great cascading over walls and in hanging baskets. Tidy plants are valued for mass bedding effects or mixed perennial borders. Perfect for container gardens.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full filtered shade; Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Appreciates slow release fertilizer twice a year.
- **Growth:** This plant will only get 2" tall making it a great groundcover as well.
- Hardiness: 3-8; Perennial
- Foliage: Deciduous
- Flowers: Small, yellow blossoms in the summer.
