## Monarda 'Leading Lady Series'

- Use: Tuck this early blooming bee balm into the front of your flower border to create a colorful swath of bright flowers and that are more compact than other bee balm on the market. Bees, butterflies and hummingbirds can't resist their sweet nectar and fragrance. Attract much needed pollinators and feed your soul with these beautiful, contained, carefree bee balms.
- **Exposure/Soil:** They prefer full sun or part morning shade with afternoon sun if warm spot in the garden. When they are growing, they do not like to dry out. When they are dormant, they like to be dry. They can be grown great in containers as well. Containers should be left dry in the garage or under an eave for the winter. They can handle cold temperatures if they are dry.
- Growth: Moderate grower to 10-14" tall by 22-28" wide
- Hardiness: Zone 4-8; Perennial Mulch around plant in the winter.
- Foliage: Deciduous. Foliage will release a spicy fragrance when crushed and can be used to make herbal tea.
- **Flower:** Cheerful flowers with a politely spreading compact habit are a fabulous addition to any perennial border. Blooms from spring to fall and this series offer 5 different colors.
