

# Evening Sun Missouri Primrose



## *Oenothera missourensis* 'Evening Sun' PP35065

- **Use:** Bright yellow flowers on silvery green foliage – flowers open in the afternoon and bloom throughout the night, attracting butterflies and moths. Tolerates a wide range of soil types; drought tolerant and low maintenance.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full–part sun. Fairly drought tolerant and needs little water once established, but prefers good drainage.
- **Growth:** Grows 3-6” high and 15-18” wide. May reseed so be sure to give it room!
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5a-9b Perennial.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. The rich dark green leaves turn bronze for the winter.
- **Flower:** Huge yellow flowers spring until fall frost open in the afternoon and bloom throughout the night, attracting butterflies and moths. Excellent for a moonlight garden.
