## Phlox divaricata 'May Breeze'

- <u>Use:</u> A delightful spring blooming native for shade, it carpets the shady border with blooms. 'May Breeze' will spread and fill in around bulbs or perennials that are late to emerge. A smallstatured wild sweet william with loose clusters of fragrant pale blue, almost white flowers that drive the butterflies wild!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Partial shade is best. Prefers moist, well drained soil, but is fairly drought tolerant once established.
- <u>Growth</u>: Grows 12-15" tall and wide. Plants will spread and can form large colonies over time.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: 7b-10; Will need protection from cold winds in our area.
- Foliage: Deciduous; Foliage is lance shaped and medium green.
- <u>Flowers</u>: White Woodland Phlox Although the flowers on this selection are described as pale blue, it reads as white in the garden. 'May Breeze' lightens up woodland areas, is sweetly fragrant, and is magical woven through sweeps of blue woodland Phlox.
