- <u>Use:</u> Phlox Jeana is a new garden phlox introduction notable for its multi-month bloom time and colorful lavender-pink clusters of sweet fragrant flowers. Garden Phlox add a punch of color and heady fragrance to any summer border. When most plants are on their summer siesta; Garden Phlox, known as the backbone of the perennial border, provide a range of welcome color. A showstopper in the garden or your favorite vase. The flowers attract butterflies and are deer resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to part sun. Water when top 3" of soil is dry. Does not like sprinklers, water soil not leaves.
- Growth: Fast growth of 3-4' tall x 2-3' wide
- Hardiness: Zone 4-9 Perennial.
- <u>Foliage</u>: Deciduous; The foliage is dense and compact with deep green, lance-shaped leaves with prominent veins. The plant's foliage has excellent mildew resistance making it a wonderful, low maintenance garden phlox.
- <u>Flower:</u> Domed clusters of densely packed, lilac pink florets are butterfly magnets late spring to fall!
