## ***Phlox subulata* 'Fort Hill'**

- **Use:** Plant a carpet of color! Beautiful masses of flowers topping creeping stems make an attractive ground cover or accent in a rock garden. Excellent bank cover. Tolerates some drought.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Sun— part sun, very easy to please. Provide well-drained, moist soil, but not soggy. Use a slow release fertilizer. Superb in borders, beds, and open woodland gardens.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower to 6 in. tall, 3 ft. wide
- **Hardiness:** 3-8, perennial
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Small trailing leaves.
- **Flower:** Small flowers in deep pink from spring— summer.
