- <u>Use:</u> Plant a carpet of color! Beautiful masses of flowers topping creeping stems make an attractive ground cover or accent in a rock garden. Excellent bank cover. Tolerates some drought.
- Exposure/Soil: Sun-part sun, very easy to please. Provide well-drained, moist soil, but not soggy. Use a slow release fertilizer. Superb in borders, beds, and open woodland gardens.
- *Growth:* Moderate grower to 6 in. tall, 3 ft. wide
- *Hardiness:* 3-8, perennial
- Foliage: Evergreen. Small trailing leaves.
- <u>Flower:</u> Small flowers in deep pink from spring summer.
