

Spring Scarlet Creeping Phlox

Phlox subulata 'Spring Scarlet'

- <u>Use:</u> Plant a carpet of color! Beautiful masses of flowers topping creeping stems make an attractive ground cover or accent in a rock garden. Excellent bank cover. Tolerates some drought. Deer resistant.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Sun- part sun, very easy to please. Provide well-drained, moist soil, but not soggy. Use a slow release fertilizer. Superb in borders, beds, and open woodland gardens.
- <u>Growth</u>: Moderate grower to 6 in. tall, 1 ft. wide. This plant will require occasional maintenance and upkeep, and should only be pruned after flowering to avoid removing any of the current season's flowers.
- *Hardiness:* Zone 3-8, perennial
- Foliage: Evergreen. Small green trailing leaves.
- <u>Flower:</u> Scarlet blooms are long lasting from spring—summer. We find a light shearing of spent blooms will bring on a new flush of blooms and denser foliage.
