excellent Winter hardiness and heat tolerance.





## Salvia x 'Blue By You'

- <u>Use:</u> Blue spikes on a free flowering compact dwarf plant.
  Vigorous and broad enough for any size garden, especially
  useful if you need a blue in the foreground. Excellent in containers or in your perennial border. Easy to grow and attracts
  hummingbirds. Fairly drought tolerant once established and
  deer resistant.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Must have good drainage.
  Drought tolerant once established
- Growth: Grows to 20–22 inches tall and 18–22 inches wide.
- *Hardiness*: Zone 4-9 perennial.
- *Foliage:* Deciduous. Fragrant, green leaves.
- <u>Flower:</u> Flower spikes are covered with beautiful blue flowers that are just outstanding! Nonstop profusion of color from April until late October! Trim back occasionally to keep a tidy plant.
