

Salvia nemerosa 'Marcus'

- <u>Use:</u> Excellent in containers or in your perennial border. Easy to grow and attracts hummingbirds. Fairly drought tolerant once established and deer resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Drought tolerant once established
- **Growth:** It has a plant height of 12" and a spread of 18-24" and stays in excellent compact form.
- Hardiness: 5-9 perennial. Mulch around plant in the winter.
- Foliage: Deciduous. With its blue-gray, lance-shaped aromatic foliage, it makes an attractive accent all summer long
- <u>Flower:</u> Glowing purple stems loaded with dark purple flowers that bloom from June to October. Nonstop profusion of color from April until late October! Trim back occasionally to keep a tidy plant.
