Salvia nemerosa 'Mainacht'

- <u>Use:</u> Excellent in containers or in your perennial border. Easy to grow and attracts hummingbirds. Fairly drought tolerant once established and deer resistant. Selected Perennial Plant of the year in 1997, one can see why.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Drought tolerant once established
- <u>Growth</u>: It has a plant height of 18" and a spread of 18-24" and stays in excellent compact form.
- *Hardiness:* 5-9 perennial. Mulch around plant in the winter.
- Foliage: Deciduous. With its blue-gray, lance-shaped aromatic foliage, it makes an attractive accent all summer long
- <u>Flower:</u> Glowing purple stems loaded with violet-purple flowers that bloom from June to October. Nonstop profusion of color from April until late October! Trim back occasionally to keep a tidy plant.

Easy to grow and comes back every year.
