## Salvia nemerosa 'Rose Marvel' PPAF

- <u>Use:</u> Rosy pink spikes on a free flowering compact dwarf plant. Vigorous and broad enough for any size garden, especially useful if you need a a powerhouse of color in the foreground. Excellent in containers or in your perennial border. Easy to grow and attracts hummingbirds. Fairly drought tolerant once established and deer resistant.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Must have good drainage. Drought tolerant once established
- **Growth:** Full, well branched plants grow 14-16" tall and 12-14" wide in one season.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: Zone 4-9 perennial. Mulch around plant in the winter.
- Foliage: Deciduous. Fragrant, green-silvery leaves.
- <u>Flower:</u> Flower spikes are covered with beautiful rosy pink flowers that are just outstanding! Nonstop profusion of color from April until late October! Trim back occasionally to keep a tidy plant.
