- <u>Use:</u> Excellent in containers or in your perennial border. Easy to grow and attracts hummingbirds. Fairly drought tolerant once established and deer resistant.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Drought tolerant once established
- **Growth**: Full, well branched plants grow 15" tall and 12" wide in one season and maintains a compact growth habit.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: Zone 5-9 Perennial. Mulch around plant in the winter.
- *Foliage:* Fragrant, green leaves. Deciduous.
- <u>Flower:</u> Medium blue flowers with a contrasting dark calyxes that stay attractive even after the flowers finish. Nonstop profusion of color from April until late October! Trim back occasionally to keep a tidy plant.
