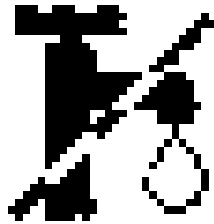


Pink Nebula Meadow Sage



Salvia nemerosa 'Pink Nebula'

- **Use:** With a long blooming season, running spring through summer, the Pink Nebula salvia brings exquisiteness to patio pots and landscapes alike. Vibrant pink flowers are excellent in combination with golden flowered annuals and perennials in the mixed border.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Good drainage a must. Drought tolerant once established
- **Growth:** It has a plant height of 8-20" and a spread of 20-22" wide and stays in excellent compact form.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Perennial. Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Fragrant, green leaves.
- **Flower:** Blooms early on dark, 8-10 in. stems that hold rosy – pink flower spikes.
