








- **Use:** A beautifully tough sedum, Mojave Jewels™ Ruby Sedum presents a field of jewel-tone flowers and tourmaline-purple foliage. This densely compact, upright sedum with strong stems emerges dusky blue-purple in spring, then transitions to deep purple as summer's heat settles in. Excellent in the landscape, rock garden and container plantings; makes a great groundcover. Fill a rock garden with these bright-toned ruby flowers, or mix them with phlox or other drought-friendly plants for xeriscaping. Deer resistant, drought tolerant, and attracts butterflies!
- Exposure/Soil: Plant in full sun. Prefers well-drained soil, but It will tolerate most soil types (but never standing water), and is drought resistant.
- **Growth**: Grows 12-15" tall and 18-20" wide.
- Hardiness: Zone 3-9; Perennial
- Foliage: Deciduous. Dusky, purplish-blue leaves.
- Flower: Late in the season, dusty lavender blooms appear and quickly change to a deep pink-red hue as the flowers age, creating a cooling contrast against the dark bluish leaves. Large clusters of ruby red flowers provide food for pollinators in fall.
