Mojave Jewels Sapphire Sedum



Landscape use: Borders, foundation plantings, small urban gardens, wildlife gardens, cutting gardens, containers





Sedum 'Mojave Jewels Sapphire PPAF'

- <u>Use:</u> This densely compact, upright sedum with strong stems emerges dusky blue-purple in spring, then transitions to deep purple as summer's heat settles in. Excellent in the landscape, rock garden and container plantings; makes a great groundcover. Prefers dry, well-drained soil in full sun. Deer resistant, drought tolerant, and attracts butterflies!
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Plant in full sun. Prefers well-drained soil, but It will tolerate most soil types and is drought resistant.
- Growth: Grows 16" tall and 12-15" wide.
- *Hardiness:* Zone 4-9; Perennial
- Foliage: Deciduous. Dusky, purplish-blue leaves.
- <u>Flower:</u> Late in the season, green blooms appear and quickly change to a rosy pink hue as the flowers age, creating a cooling contrast against the dark bluish leaves. Large clusters of flowers provide food for pollinators in fall.
