Variegated Purple heart / Setcreasea



Super easy to grow in sun or shade!

Setcreasea pallida / Tradescantia pallida 'Variegata'

- <u>Use</u>: This new Variegated Purple Heart does well in shady spots and makes a good plant for growing under trees, just be sure to plant in a low traffic area as the stems are very breakable It will need a well drained rich soil planted in partial shade, but will tolerate full sun in a south or east setting. Looks excellent planted with Lantanas, Coleus, Petunias, Daylilies, or any plant with yellow foliage.
- Exposure/Soil: Full sun to part shade or at least 5-6 hours of afternoon sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. Drought tolerant once established.
- <u>Growth:</u> This plant can be used as a groundcover, only reaching 12" tall and 2-3 ft wide.
- Hardiness: 6-9 perennial
- Foliage: Deciduous. It has lance shaped leaves that sometimes get as big as 7 inches and is loved for it's dark purple and pinkcolor.
- **Flower:** In mid summer Purple Heart will have small pink flowers with bright yellow stamens at the tip of each section.
