- Use: The silvery white leaves of this ground cover add distinctive color and texture to beds and borders. Gracefully defining garden spaces and marking boundaries between lawn and gardenit makes a great low border edging. Garden visitors will enjoy the soft feel of the foliage. Excellent low-and drought tolerant once established perennial.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Sun-part shade. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- Growth: Quickly reaches 6-8 in. tall, gradually spreading to form a dense mat 12 in wide.
- **Hardiness: Zone** 4-8; Perennial
- Foliage: Semi-evergreen; 4 inch long velvety, soft, lamb's earshaped leaves; light gray-green and covered with white hairs

Flower: Not known for flowers.
