- <u>Use:</u> This wonderful verbena was discovered by the Georgia Gang (Dirr and Armitage) at...where else...an old homestead. This vigorous grower is literally covered with medium dark purple flowers backed by clean, dark green foliage all summer...WOW! 'Homestead Purple' can leap small plants in a single bound. OUR FAVORITE!!! Great in baskets, planters, or anywhere in the sun! <u>Georgia Gold Medal Winner!</u>
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Sun-part sun. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Water when top 3" of soil is dry. Do not water center of the plant, try to water under the leaves. Drought tolerant once established.
- Growth: Grows 8" tall and continues to trail 1-2' a year wide
- Hardiness: 6-10, Perennial
- Foliage: Deciduous
- *Flower*: Over 5 months of purple blooms.
