
Astronaut Azalea





- <u>Use:</u> Beautiful evergreen, premier shrub for use as hedge, screen or massed planting for impressive color display.
 <u>Exposure/Soil:</u> Part shade preferred, but will tolerate more sun after established. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
 - **Growth:** Large grower to 3 to 4 feet tall and wide.
 - *Hardiness*: Zone 6-9; Shrub hardy -5F
 - <u>Foliage</u>: Evergreen; Even the leaves are notably smaller, making it the wonderful bonzai plant that it was originally bred to be.
 - <u>Flower:</u> Grows 4" to 5" variable white single with light green blush and light pink wash, few pink to rosy-red lines and dashes, 6 ruffled and imbricated lobes, very heavy substance.



This is a front of the border azalea because of its lower height. Perfect for the smaller garden.
