Azalea Conversation Piece



This azalea flaunts year-round beauty... but this flowering shrub's claim to fame is its sizeable, striking pink blooms that can measure up to four inches across.

Azalea 'Conversation Piece'

- <u>Use</u>: Dazzling pink flowers stand out against rich dark green foliage, for a timeless and elegant addition to any outdoor living space. The Conversation Piece's first round of flowers comes with the arrival of spring. Hummingbirds love these flowers, so keep your binoculars handy for enhanced viewing.
- Low mounding, late bloomer with large wavy petals. Flower color on this
 Robin Hill azalea can range from dark pink to nearly white with blotches of
 darker pink in the center of the flowers on the same plant. Flower size can
 be nearly four inches across. It is among the late spring flowering azaleas.
- Exposure/Soil: Part shade. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy.
- Growth: Moderate grower to 2-4' tall and 3-5 ft. wide. Low and spreading. Makes an attractive ground cover.
- *Hardiness: 6*-9; shrub
- <u>Foliage</u>: Tiny evergreen foliage on a low spreading form.
 - **Flower:** They may vary in color, but are basically white with spotted blotches of light and dark pink. There may be many different colored blossoms on one plant. This azalea superstar is a re-blooming hybrid, which means that you can look forward to a repeat performance as fall approaches.
