- <u>Use</u>: The Bloom 'N Again® Azaleas have been carefully selected for their repeat blooming habit and cold hardiness. All the Bloom 'N Again® Azaleas are evergreen shrubs good for planting in mass or integrated into a hedge or shrub border. With little need to prune, they are perfect for a naturalized area such as a shade or woodland garden.  - **Exposure/Soil:** Part shade. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- <u>Growth</u>: Moderate grower to 2 feet tall and 4 feet wide. Compact spreading habit.
- *Hardiness*: 6-9; Shrub
- Foliage: Evergreen. Large medium green leaves.
- **Flower:** Gorgeous, 2.5-3" white hose-in-hose double flowers midlate season spring and again in fall.
