
Hino Crimson Azalea



Azalea 'Hino Crimson'

- <u>Use:</u> This tough azalea thrives in very cold climates! A low growing, compact plant with single flowers that are colored crimson (pinkish-red). Premier flowering shrub for use as hedge, walkway border or in massed planting for impressive color display.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun to shade. We don't recommend full sun unless you have fantastic soil and irrigation. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth**: Moderate grower to 2 to 4 ft. tall, 3 to 5 ft. wide. .
- *Hardiness:* 4 -9 Shrub
- **Foliage**: Evergreen; The glossy, dark green leaves are small and turn bronze in winter.
- <u>Flower:</u> Profusion of single, crimson blooms. Blooms late March to Early April.
