
Green Velvet Boxwood

Buxus 'Green Velvet'

- <u>Use:</u> A full bodied boxwood well suited for dense, low hedges.
 Foliage retains its rich green color throughout winter. Vigorous, rounded form if left unsheared.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Only requires well-drained soil and prefers shading and wind protection in winter if grown on an exposed site. Tolerates some drought and will grow in dry soil but prefers well-drained, loamy, sandy or clay soils with a pH of acidic to slightly alkaline (6.8-7.7)
- Growth: Moderate grower to 2 to 4 ft. tall and 1-3' wide, when unpruned. However often shaped to 2' tall in topiary form.
- Hardiness: 5-10; Shrub
- *Foliage:* Evergreen; Small, obovate, medium green leaves (to 5/8" long).
- Flower: Spring flowers are inconspicuous.
