Buxus microphylla var. japonica

- <u>Use:</u> Excellent evergreen shrub for small hedges.
 Retains its dark green foliage in the hottest summers, becoming bronze-tinged in winter.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Prefers full sun to part shade.
 Keep surface of soil moist, but not soggy.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower to 4 to 6 ft. tall and wide, when unpruned. However often shaped to 2' tall in topiary form.
- *Hardiness:* 5-10; Shrub
- *Foliage:* Evergreen; Small, obovate, medium green leaves (to 5/8" long).
- *Flower:* Spring flowers are inconspicuous.
