- <u>Growth</u>: Moderate growing to 6 to 8 ft. tall and wide, larger with age.
- Hardiness: 6-9; shrub
- *Foliage:* Vigorous, compact, upright, evergreen shrub, valued for small pale green foliage.
- <u>Flower:</u> Shell pink semi-double blossoms. Blooms from December through March. <u>Prune only right after blooms fade.</u>
