- <u>Use:</u> A spectacular flowering evergreen ornamental shrub which should be planted in semi shade in slightly acidic, well drained semi-moist soil. Can be used in general landscaped gardens, as a flowering specimen in the garden or in a pot where the flowers will put on a showy display in late winter. The flowers can be used as a floral display. Flowers make a dazzling contrast with the glossy, dark green foliage. An old favorite.
- *Exposure:* Prefers sheltered site, sunny or shade, and any well drained neutral/acid soil.
- <u>Growth</u>: Moderate growing to 4 to 5 ft. tall and wide, larger with age.
- *Hardiness:* 6-9; shrub
- *Foliage:* Vigorous, compact, upright, evergreen shrub, valued for small pale green foliage.
- *Flower:* Light pink to white with pinkish center and faint border up to 2" wide. Prune only right after blooms fade.

Tolerates heat and humidity well!
