Camellia japonica 'Lady Vansittart'

- <u>Use:</u> Moderate-slow growing evergreen shrub with wavyedged glossy dark green leaves. A must have for every Southern garden to add winter interest. Also makes an excellent hedge.
 - <u>Exposure</u>: Prefers sheltered site, sunny or shade, and any well drained neutral/acid soil. Extreme summer heat may cause leaf burn; needs some shade if planted near a white house due to reflection of sun.
 - Growth: Low growing to 8ft. tall and wide, larger with age.
 - *Hardiness:* 6-9; shrub
 - Foliage: Evergreen, glossy.
 - <u>Flower</u>: Medium sized, semi-double white flowers irregularly striped rose-pink. Sometimes produces flower sports with white margined, pink petals, streaked deeper pink. <u>Prune only right after blooms fade</u>.
