## Look Again Camellia







Tolerates heat and humidity well! We love to plant them in large hedges for year round beauty in part shade.



## Camellia japonica 'Look Again'

- <u>Use:</u> With multiple flower colors on the one bush, this variety makes you "Look Again" to confirm your eyes aren't deceiving you! A long flowering variety with blooms that are generally white to light pink but can also be pure white or solid pink on the same bush at the same time! Look Again can produce a mixed floral display on its own! As a solid growing variety it makes for a talking point in your Camellia display. The sensational blossoms can be used as a corsage or floated in a bowl of water to add beauty to any room.
- <u>Exposure</u>: Prefers sheltered site, prefers morning sun and a little bit of shade from afternoon sun, and any well drained neutral/acid soil.
- <u>Growth:</u> Moderate growing to 8 to 12 ft. tall and wide, and 6-8 feet wide at the base. Prune only right after flowering to avoid cutting out following year's buds (they set flowers 9 months in advance).
- *Hardiness:* Zone 7b-9; Shrub
- <u>Foliage</u>: Evergreen. Glossy dark green, ovate leaves with finely serrated edges.
- <u>Flower</u>: A real conversation piece, it may have bicolor, solid white, or solid pink flowers on the same bush at the same time in later winter. A conversation starter for sure! It's long bloom period makes it a must have for every Southern Garden. <u>Prune only right after blooms fade.</u>
