- <u>Use:</u> A vigorous, spreading camellia with white, formal flowers, Morning Glow is as lovely as its name. Introduced in 1948, this stately plant produces a heavy bud set and then blooms early and long. Morning Glow fits that bill for creating great winter interest in your garden.
- <u>Exposure</u>: Prefers sheltered site, sunny or shade, and any well drained neutral/acid soil.
- **Growth:** Moderate growing to 6 to 8 ft. tall and wide, larger with age.
- Hardiness: 6-9; shrub
- *Foliage:* Vigorous, compact, upright, evergreen shrub, valued for small pale green foliage.
- <u>Flower</u>: Admired for its pure white, formal double blooms from December through March. <u>Prune only right after</u> <u>blooms fade.</u>
