## Camellia sasanqua 'Brandy's Temper'

- <u>Use:</u> Camellias are used as specimen shrubs, shrub borders and screens. The main ornamental feature is their showy flowers in colder winter months when other plants are dormant. Similar to C. japonica but tends to be smaller and more refined. Smaller leaves. Compact grower with a pendulous bushy habit. Heavy bud set.
- **Exposure:** Thrives in partial sun (Morning Sun), but may tolerate full sun with good irrigation, excellent soil (and some work!), . Must amend the soil! They hate red clay! Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- <u>Growth</u>: Can grow 5' tall and 3' wide. Space plants 3' apart to create a hedge.
- Hardiness: 6-9; shrub
- Foliage: Evergreen. Shiny, rich dark green leaves.
- <u>Flower:</u> Dark pink, semi-double blossoms from September to November. Fragrant blossoms eventually drop their petals like snow; creating a great late autumn scene.
