
Purple Haze Camellia



Special Buy! Create a wall of gorgeous winter blooming flowers with by plant-

ing a hedge of Camellias or use as a stand alone specimen.



- Use: The small leaved Sasanqua Camellias make excellent landscape or container plants and are much more tolerant of sun and soil conditions than the larger flowered Japonica Camellias. These durable evergreen shrubs cover themselves in 2-3" flowers in fall and early winter and before the flowers fade the petals fall individually to form a colorful blanket beneath the dark glossy green foliage.
- **Exposure:** Thrives in either full sun (with good irrigation and some work), but prefers partial sun (Morning Sun). Must amend the soil, as they hate red clay! Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- Growth: Moderate grower to 4-5' tall and 3-4' wide. Space plants 4'-6' apart to create a hedge.
- Hardiness: Zone 6-9; Shrub
- Foliage: Evergreen. Shiny, rich dark green leaves.
 - **Flower:** Medium sized 2-3" perfect red, purplish-red, to purple blossoms emerge in profusion in mid fall and flowering may continue well into January. Cool weather helps to produce the purple tones. We love cutting the flowers and floating them in a vase of water.
