Camellia sasanqua 'Setsugeka'

- <u>Use:</u> This elegant fall blooming camellia has large pristine white semi-double flowers with golden centers of bright stamens. The flowers are borne a few at a time from early autumn to the end of December. The glossy, dark evergreen foliage covers lax flowing branches that are easy to train as an espalier or on to a trellis.
- **Exposure:** Thrives in either full sun with good irrigation (and some work), but prefers partial sun (Morning Sun). Must amend the soil! As they hate red clay! Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- <u>Growth</u>: Moderate growing; reaches 8 to 10 ft. tall and wide. Space plants 6-8' apart to create a hedge.
- Hardiness: Zone 6-9; shrub
- Foliage: Evergreen. Shiny, rich dark green leaves.
- <u>Flower</u>: Large, perfectly formed, semi-double, white flowers with ruffled edges and a bright center of golden stamens. A midseason bloomer.
