Camellia x 'Twilight Glow'

- <u>Use:</u> Flowers make a dazzling contrast with the glossy, dark green foliage. A C.oleifera x C.sasanqua F² segregate, offered as a cold hardy selection. Could make a nice evergreen hedge with pruning or a single specimen.
- Exposure: Prefers sheltered site, sunny or shade, and any well drained neutral/acid soil. Yellowing leaves indicate acidity too low. Fertilize monthly in spring and summer. If desired, remove all but one bud from each cluster to increase the size of the flower. Prune immediately after flowering.
- <u>Growth</u>: Moderate growing to 6 to 8 ft. tall and wide, larger with age.
 Medium bushy shape.
- Hardiness: Zone 6-9; shrub
- <u>Foliage</u>: Vigorous, compact, upright, evergreen shrub, valued for small pale green foliage.
- <u>Flower:</u> Small, single, rose coloured flowers, bell-shaped at first, then opening wider. They tend to open all at once, covering the plant, midautumn. Blooms from December through March. <u>Prune only right after blooms fade.</u>
