• <u>Use:</u> Darling dark pink flowers on a Bluebeard! Brings a bright pop of pink to the late summer landscape with cheery pink flowers. Attracts pollinators, butterflies, and hummingbirds in droves. Produces tons of blooms on a compact habit. A great addition to the perennial border and as a backdrop with grasses.



- Exposure/Soil: Prefers full sun to part sun. Avoid heavy wet clay soils. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry to start. Little water needed once established.
 - **Growth:** Grows 2-3 feet tall and 2-3 feet wide.
- needs lit- Hardiness: Zone 7b-9b; Perennial/ Shrub
- **tle water once es-** Deciduous. Low arching habit and bright green foliage are a perfect complement in the perennial border.
- **tablished.** <u>*Flower:*</u> Features clusters of clean, deep pink flowers that run up and down the stems from late spring until fall.
