- **Use:** *The hardest caryopteris yet!* Sunshine Blue II is a new, improved variety of the classic Sunshine Blue, but it's much more tolerant of cold climates. You will enjoy the vivid gold foliage and blue blooms of this late blooming favorite. An excellent plant for attracting pollinators! A great companion plant with grasses in the perennial border.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to part sun. Avoid heavy wet clay soils. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry to start. Little water needed once established.
- **Growth:** Grows 2-3 feet tall and 2-3 feet wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9; Perennial/ Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Bright yellow foliage shines from spring to fall.
- **Flower:** Bountiful dark blue blooms appear in summer until fall! Excellent for pollinators.
