Chaenomeles speciosa 'Cameo'

- <u>Use:</u> Cameo Quince is a deciduous shrub that flowers a double, apricot-pink flower in late winter. A good choice for use as a hedge, in mixed borders, and mass planting.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full sun to light shade. Flowering is best in full sun. Tolerant of most soils including very dry soils.
- **Growth:** Moderate growing 2 to 3 feet tall by 4 to 5 feet wide.
- *Hardiness:* 4-9, shrub
- *Foliage:* Evergreen. Small green leaves.
- *Flower:* Double apricot-pink flowers in late winter.
