Collector's plant! Excellent for adding interest to your garden!

Chamaecyparis obtusa 'Conschlecht' PP24666

- <u>Use:</u> Excellent foliage that becomes a nice bronze color in the winter months. Nice dense, rounded habit. No burn has been noticed during outdoor trials in full sun. The most inner part of the leaves retains a green color.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full/part sun and could tolerate a fair amount of shade, but then may lose golden color; welldraining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer.
- <u>Growth</u>: Slowly maturing to 4' tall by 5' wide; the goldenyellow color stays that way if the plant is sited in full sun.
 Can be kept shorter with yearly pruning.
- *Hardiness:* Zone 5-8; shrub
- *Foliage:* Evergreen. Excellent golden foliage that becomes bronze in winter, while the inner foliage stays green.
- Flowers: Not known for flowers.
