- <u>Use</u>: An outstanding alternative to commonly used species such as cherry laurels, junipers, hollies, Indian hawthorn, and even boxwood. Extremely hardy - pest & disease resistant, drought tolerant, wet soil tolerant, and thrive in full sun to partial shade. Makes a wonderful, thick, yet graceful looking hedge or groundcover planting.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Grows in full to part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Will tolerate wet soil.
- Growth: Grows 2' tall and 5-6' wide.
- *Hardiness:* Zone 6b-10 ; Shrub
- <u>Foliage</u>: Evergreen; Beautiful dark green coloration year round, with just a slight bluish cast.
- **Flower:** Very small reddish maroon flowers appear in late winter, which also gives this plant some nice seasonal interest too.
