- <u>Use:</u> Large fan-shaped leaves add a bold tropical look to the landscape. Great in shaded entryways or patio; perfect for containers or as houseplants. This Japanese selection of the popular, deep shadeloving southern landscape shrub, Fatsia japonica, is prized by the few folks who have had the rare opportunity to own one.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Part sun-shade; well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. Water when top 3 in of soil is dry.
- <u>Growth</u>: Moderate grower to 5 feet tall, equal width. It takes about 3
 years for it to show the wonderful mature characteristics, so be patient.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: 7-9; Shrub or Houseplant. We recommend you plant them on a protected wall away from extreme winter cold. For those who garden in the arctic zones north of Zone 7, these make superb houseplants.
- <u>Foliage</u>: Evergreen; The shiny green palmate leaves, like a supersized schefflera, are each bordered with a heavy white speckling that often finds its way into the center of the leaf.
- **Flowers:** White flower clusters are followed by black berries.
