Gardenia jasminoides 'Frost Proof'

- <u>Use:</u> Excellent in low borders or as a ground cover. Great container plant. New Frost Proof Gardenias are unaffected by cold snaps and thrive on neglect. They adapt to a variety of soil conditions... do great in partial shade... and resist insects and disease. Even deer leave them alone. They're just as beautiful as they are tough. You get huge, velvety white flowers that bloom in pairs.
- Exposure/Soil: Full sun (only with good irrigation system)/part sun preferred; well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. Water regularly when top 3in of soil is dry. Must amend the soil if you have red clay! We recommend our coconut peat soil mix.
- **Growth:** Moderate, spreading grower to 3-4 feet tall, 3 to 6 feet wide.
- *Hardiness: 7*-9; shrub
- *Foliage:* Glossy green and white leaves, evergreen.
- Flowers: Same great fragrance as larger gardenias, but having a lower, rounded form enhanced with fragrant white flowers
