- <u>Use:</u> The same useful narrow habit, but with stunning new flowers! Each one of Red Pillar® rose of Sharon's plentiful blooms is a big red bullseye. Perfect for drawing in pollinators and visitors as a specimen or hedge. Practically maintenance-free, this new tree variety will steal the show in your garden.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Grow in full sun in ordinary soil. To increase bloom and to shape, prune to 2 buds per branch when dormant. Prefers to be watered under the leaves.
- *Growth:* Maturing to heights of 10-16 feet tall and 4-5' wide.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: Zone 5a-9b Shrub/ Small Tree. Very heat tolerant!
- *Foliage:* Deciduous; Medium green maple-like leaves.
- *Flower:* Mid-summer deep magenta blooms emerge with a cherry red eye blooming into Fall.
