- **Use:** An improved version of the original pink 'Annabelle' hydrangea.
 - Invincibelle Spirit II hydrangea represents the best in full-sized pink 'Annabelle' hydrangeas. It offers handsome, dark green foliage, sturdy, strong stems that prevent flopping, and large blooms of deep pink that age to an \$1 from each Invincibelle® Spirit II sold is donated to The Breast Cancer Research Foundation®.  - **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in a part sun (morning sun/afternoon shade preferred), well-drained spot; some early afternoon shade is beneficial in hot southern regions. Prune in late winter or early spring. Soil pH does not affect flower color.
 - **Growth:** It reaches just 3.5' -4' tall and wide; naturally grows as a tidy, rounded mound.
 - **Hardiness:** Zone 3a-8a; Shrub
 - **Foliage:** Deciduous. Coarsely toothed, glossy, dark-green leaves.
 - **Flower:** Produces loads of snowball shaped blooms from early summer to first frost. Dark pink buds open to hot pink flowers, fading to soft pink and finally to green. This hardy adaptable native selection is a reliable bloomer, even after the harshest of winters, and is also quite heat tolerant.
