- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Plant in a partsun, well-drained spot; some early afternoon shade is beneficial in hot southern regions. Prune in late winter or early spring. Soil pH does not affect flower color.
- <u>Growth</u>: It reaches just 1-2.5' (.3-.7 m) tall and naturally grows as a tidy, rounded mound.
- Hardiness: Zone 3-9; Shrub
- Foliage: Deciduous. Coarsely toothed, glossy, dark-green leaves.
- Flower: Each pure-white flower is held up on a strong, supportive stem for a display that looks more like a bouquet of flowers than a landscape plant. Blooming begins in early summer and continues through frost, with new flowers appearing the whole time.
