Hydrangea macrophylla 'Penny Mac'

- <u>Use</u>: This Hydrangea is a repeat bloomer like the 'Endless Summer' with large 7-inch flowers, and pretty much considered an everbloomer in the warmer climates. Enjoy these booms in fresh arrangements or dry out the blooms and use them all Winter.
- Exposure/Soil: Prefers morning sun, afternoon shade, and a moist, well-drained soil. Avoid planting it on hot, dry, exposed sites. DO NOT PLANT IN FULL SUN! Most striking color is achieved in acid earth. In neutral soil, both pink and blue flowers appear. With adding lime and elevating the pH they will turn pink. Add Aluminum Sulfate for a deeper blue, but they usually turnblue in our low pH soils without amendment.
- **Growth**: Fast-growing to 4 feet high; equal width in only 3 –4 years.
- *Hardiness:* 5-9 Shrub
- Foliage: Deciduous. Handsome foliage on boldly branched, mounded form.
- Flower: Clusters of deep blue flower heads throughout summer!
