Ilex x 'Mary Nell'

- <u>Use:</u> A superb hedge, screen or specimen. Mary Nell is the combination of three Hollies, first llex cornuta 'Burfordii' was crossed with llex pernyi 'Red Delight' the result of this cross was then crossed with llex latifolia.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Sun-part shade. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy.
- *Growth:* Slow growing to10-15' tall & 6-8' wide.
- *Hardiness:* 5-9; Shrub
 - <u>Foliage</u>: Evergreen. Has oval, minutely scalloped light green leaves with points on each tip. This Holly is great at maintaining a manicured look with little effort and produces bright red clusters of berries.
- Flower: Inconspicuous white flowers in spring.
