Green Luster Holly



Best known for use as planting under windows up near the home.

llex crenata 'Green Luster'

- <u>Use:</u> It makes an excellent evergreen foundation planting or hedge, or as an evergreen background for bulbs and flowering perennials.
- Exposure/Soil: Full sun to part shade. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. Water if it hasn't rained in 2 weeks.
- <u>Growth</u>: This is a low growing, spreading variety of Japanese Holly with a dwarf mounding habit spreading up to 5' in width, but only reaching a maximum of 3' in height.
- *Hardiness:* 6-8, shrub
- <u>Foliage</u>: Small green leaves. Evergreen.
- <u>Flower:</u> Not known for flowers. Small, black berries not very visible.
