Will tolerate damp or dry soils and can be turned into a hedge.

Illicium parviflora

- <u>Use:</u> This shrub has aromatic foliage which smells similar to anise. A native to the South Eastern portion of the country and is more tolerant of sun and dry soil then other Illiciums but it can also tolerate damp soils. <u>Exposure/Soil:</u> Prefers part sun to shade. Keep surface of soil moist, but not soggy. Provide humus-rich, moist, but well-drained soil for best performance.
- <u>Growth</u>: Moderate-growing 8-10 ft. tall, 3-4' wide or more.
- *Hardiness:* 3-7 Shrub Evergreen.
- *Foliage:* The leaves are olive green in color.
- Flower: The flowers are yellow and have many petals in summer.
